The plaintiff requests a direction that the defendant will advise the plaintiff by the end of December, 2016 whether or not it consents to the proposed amendments, and if it opposes, parties will set an application to resolve the same on a date that is mutually convenient within the first 90 days of 2017.</p> <p>b) Daniel H. Coles is acting for the plaintiff under the terms of a limited scope retainer. To date this arrangement has caused concern for defendant's counsel. The plaintiff seeks a direction that Daniel H. Coles is entitled to attend and conduct examination for discoveries on behalf of the plaintiff, and appear on behalf of the plaintiff in court without filing a notice of intention to act.</p>
